Mary Zmolek studied applied art at Iowa State University. After learning the Scandinavian art of rose mauling, she studied oil painting under Bulgarian master Dimitar Krustev, joining him on several painting ventures in Europe and Mexico. A winner of many local and regional awards for her paintings, Mary has led painting classes out of her home and at the YMCA and has painted many locally commissioned portraits.



Pauli Zmolek is a graduate of the University of Iowa art program. She also studied under Mr. Krustev before attending the Schuler School of Fine Art in Baltimore. She then served for ten years as a decorative artist at the U.S. Capitol and the Library of Congress in Washington, DC.
